
Local Area Network

A LAN is a group of computers, printers and other interconnected devices.

Characteristics of a LAN include:

- 1. Limited geographic operation
- 2. High speed data transfer rates
- 3. Full time connectivity to local services
- 4. Generally lower in cost than a WAN

Two major issues when designing and implementing a LAN include:


- 1. Distance

LAN Transmission Methods


LAN transmission methods fall into 3 main categories:
