Terms & Conditions

- 1. The grantee organization will furnish to the Department of Science & Technology, financial year wise Utilization Certificate (UC) in the proforma prescribed as per GFR 2017 and audited statement of expenditure (SE) along with up to date progress report (Vis-a-Vis Target Vs-Achievement) at the end of each financial year duly reflecting the interest earned / accrued on the grant received under the project. This is also subject to the condition of submission of the final statement of expenditure, utilization certificate and project completion report within one year from the scheduled date of completion of the project.
- 2. The grantee organization will have to enter & upload the Utilization Certificate in the PFMS portal besides sending it in physical form to this Division. The subsequent/final installment will be released only after confirmation of the acceptance of the UC by the Division and entry of previous Utilization Certificate in the PFMS.
- 3. If the grant has been released under capital head through separate sanction order under the same project for purchase of equipment(s), separate SE/UC has to be furnished for the released Capital head grant.
- 4. The grant-in-aid being released is subject to the condition that:
 - a) A transparent procurement procedure in line with Provisions of General Financial Rules 2017 will be followed by the Institute/Organization under the appropriate rules of grantee organization while procuring capital assets sanctioned for the above mentioned project and a certificate to this effect will be submitted by the Grantee organization immediately on receipt of the grant.
 - b) While submitting Utilization Certificate/Statement of Expenditure, the organization has to be ensure submission of supporting documentary evidences with regard of the purchase of equipment/capital assets as per the provisions of GFR 2017. Subsequent release of grants under the project shall be considered only on receipt of the said documents.
- 5. The Meeting started with thank you note to the Committee chairman Dr RK Jain.

Visit was made the bio gas pilot plant which was found in operation and producing the gas which was available to burnt in the burner with a blue flame and found satisfactory.

Suggestion was given to PI to display a small tag/name plate showing the project supported by DST on all the equipments and plant developed under the project.

Subsequently the PI presented the progress of the project through a Power point presentation made by Dr. Sangeeta, PI in the project. The progress in the activity were satisfactory, However some suggestions given for the future remaining by Dr. R. K. Jain

- 1) Generation of more scientific data related to the optimisation of the process parameters in respect of Temperature, time, Material to liquor ratio, substrate characteristics & its particle size vis-a-vis gas production efficiency.
- 2) Addition of special seeds for better gas output (source name to be suggested by Dr. R. K. Jain)
- 3) Segregation of kitchen waste into processed (left out cooked food) and unprocessed food (vegetables peelings, leaves and stem, remains of dressed vegetables, such as green pea, green gram, etc.), determine their percentage ratio weight wise.
- 4) Pre digestion of unprocessed kitchen waste with steam at specific temp. and time duration.

Measure the following parameters with and without predigested food.

pH

Temperature

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- Gas production efficiency
- COD

The progress of the project was found to be satisfactorily, The Committee recommended for the extension of the project duration for the 6 months to complete the scientific data generation work. The committee also recommended for the additional grant to be provided to the PI i.e. for the extended period of the project for the Salary of the one manpower i.e. one Project Assistant @ Rs.22,000/- pm for six months having M.Sc (chemistry) qualification with consumable and Travel grant of Rs.50,000/- each i.e. total of Rs. 2,32,000/-.

The Committee also suggested the services of the JRF may now be terminated by giving one month notice as at present now his services are not needed in implementation of the project. However the services of the Field Assistant to be remains continue even in extended period with salary if needed saving of the project may be used for this purpose or additional funds may be provided by the DST for fruitful implementation of the project
