ACTION TAKEN REPORT BASED ON STUDENTS' FEEDBACK **A.Y. 2023-2024**

The College obtained the feedback on design and review of syllabus, facilities provided and teaching learning process from students to improve the process of teaching and learning. The feedback was based on a structured questionnaire. The data was analyzed and a feedback report was prepared in order to gain insights into the area where improvements are needed. On the basis of the feedback following actions were taken to incorporate the improvements suggested by students.

ACTION TAKEN

S. No.	Feedback/Suggestions	Action Taken
1	Students gave feedback for more international exposure.	A decision was taken to explore the possibility of collaboration with foreign universities for the purpose of collaborative conference, internship and research project.
2	More motivation for participation in challenges/hackathons.	Department has started Internships, Competitive Coding Challenges, Research based projects
3	More external lecturers should be invited for understanding of the industry.	Subject experts to be invited more in number to give lectures and engage in one-on-one interactions with students.
4	Students suggested regarding teaching-learning methodologies.	It was decided that courses on Google cloud program will be offered to the students and one faculty and two students will coordinate the program.
5	Some students require career counseling and guidance towards higher studies	College arranged alumni panel interaction programs along with fully functional Counseling cell. More career guidance and soft skill development schemes have been implemented.

6	Library Resources	Books of latest editions are regularly purchased in libraries as per the course syllabus.
7	Value added courses to be implemented according to demand of the industry	It was decided to launch some courses which are in demand as per the industry requirement, so we started courses like web designing and data science. We made a WhatsApp group according to the area of interest of students and alumni to enhance peer-to-peer learning. It was decided that practical oriented subject should be aligned according to the requirement of industry
8	More recreational and teambuilding events.	The students were taken for picnics/ outings/ national and international educational tours department-wise for recreational, educational and teambuilding exercises
9	Students should be made aware of placement of the courses	Students are made aware of outcome of the programme during Orientation Program in the beginning.
